Environment Minister of the State of Baden-Württemberg Franz Untersteller visits Felss in Königsbach-Stein.

On 18 January, Felss welcomed the Baden-Württemberg Minister for the Environment, Climate and Energy to the company headquarters in Königsbach-Stein.
